

CORRIGENDUM

DSC is not required for Registration of Tax Deductors (DDOs)

DSC is not necessary for the Tax Deductors (other than companies) to obtain registration. In order to offer a simple registration process, the mandatory provision of DSC is removed and made optional only. As per new relaxation, a Tax Deductor (DDO) shall fill all the fields of GST REG -7 Form in GST Portal @ www.gst.gov.in and select "Save" button in place of "Submit with DSC". Once a correct and completed Application form with uploaded documents is saved, the Tax Deductor gets registered subject to verification of the contents of application. The processing of application for verification may take 2/3 days and once it is approved the Registration Certificate will be made available at the registered e-mail address.
