# GOVERNMENT OF ASSAM ORDERS BY THE GOVERNOR FINANCE (TAXATION) DEPARTMENT

#### **NOTIFICATION**

The 24th January, 2022

**No.FTX.56/2017/Pt-V/65.-** In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 50 of the Assam Goods and Services Tax Act, 2017 (Assam Act No. XXVIII of 2017) (hereinafter referred to as the "said Act"), read with section 148 of the said Act, the Governor of Assam, on the recommendations of the Council, is hereby pleased to make the following further amendments in notification No. FTX.56/2017/33 dated the 29th June, 2017 issued by the Finance (Taxation) Department, Government of Assam, published in the Assam Gazette, Extraordinary, No. 354, dated the 29th June, 2017, namely:—

In the said notification, in the first paragraph, in the first proviso,-

- for the words, letters and figure "required to furnish the returns in FORM GSTR-3B, but fail to furnish the said return along with payment of tax", the words "liable to pay tax but fail to do so" shall be substituted;
- (ii) in the Table, in column 4, in the heading, for the words "Tax period", the words "Month/Quarter" shall be substituted;
- (iii) in the Table, for serial number 3, 4, 5 and 6, the following shall be substituted, namely:—
