Sub : Issuance of statutory forms.

It has been represented by a number of dealers, specially the tea gardens that they have to pay the fees through treasury for which the whole process of procurement of statutory forms get delayed. Moreover, procedure for making payment of only Rs.2/- through the treasury is cumbersome and expensive in terms of manpower and hidden cost. In this connection, it may be brought to the notice of all concerned that fees can be deposited directly into the Designated Banks which will save time. Also larger amount can be deposited against fees for the forms and the same can be used as and when the forms are required. The Unit Offices can keep proper accounts of the amount utilized so that proper fees are realized and at the same time the dealer is not harassed.

All Assistant Commissioners of Taxes/Superintendents of Taxes are directed to keep strict vigil for speedy disposal of the application for Road Permit and other Statutory Forms after necessary verification of the utilization of earlier issued forms etc.



